

YEAR ONE SPRING TERM CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

PE- In P.E. this term, children will focus on improving and applying their basic skills in games. Children will show awareness of opponents and team-mates when playing games; perform basic skills of rolling, striking and kicking with more confidence.



Mathematics- We will be covering a variety of topics involving number, shape and space, data handling, measures, and problem solving. It would be a great help over the next few weeks if you could practise number bonds to 20, solving problems using money, adding and subtracting one digit and two digit numbers.



ICT-Children will learn that information exists in a variety of forms, including text, still and moving pictures, charts and sounds and that different media are used for different purposes.



English-In the spring term, we will develop our writing skills by focusing on recounts. Children will get the opportunity to recount on different events. We will also be focusing on the story 'The Gingerbread Man'. Children will get the opportunity to focus on a range of poems which have pattern and rhyme. Please continue to support your child in writing sentences using capital letters and full stops.

Science- This half term in science, children will focus on the topic growing plants. Children will grow their own plants and track the growth of the plant.

Geography- Children will be learning about the weather. They learn about the different types of weather and make associations between weather and seasons.



R.E-Children will be focusing on the festivals of light which is also known as 'Diwali'. Children will also learn to recognise that light is used as a religious symbol and will learn how people from different faiths celebrate.



PSHE- Children will develop their understanding on the roles of different people in the local community.
