

# YEAR ONE SUMMER TERM CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

**PE-** In P.E. this term, children will explore basic gymnastic actions. Children will show awareness of basic control and coordination when travelling and when remaining still; choose and link 'actions; remember and repeat these actions accurately and consistently; find and use space safely, with an awareness of others.



**Mathematics-** We will be covering a variety of topics involving number, shape and space, data handling, measures, and problem solving. It would be a great help over the next few weeks if you could practise number bonds to 20, solving problems using money, adding and subtracting one digit and two digit numbers.



**ICT-**Children will use key words to label and classify objects. They will use personal description to describe a variety of objects.



**English-**In the summer term, we will focus on poetry. Children will read poems aloud to hear rhyme and rhythm. Children will also focus on the little red riding hood as part of traditional tales. Children will re-enact the different scenes of the story and develop story writing. Please continue to support your child in writing sentences using capital letters and full stops.

**Science-** This half term in science, children will observe and compare movements they make and movements of objects in terms of speed or direction.

**Geography-** Children will be learning about the seaside. They will identify how sea sides were in the past and how they are today.



**Art & Design-**Children will be designing and making their own moving pictures. They will develop understanding of how movement can be created by investigating everyday products.



**PSHE-** Children will learn that animals have needs just like humans, and that needs include food, water and a place to live. They begin to appreciate the ways in which humans have a responsibility towards all animals.
