



Literacy:

Language and sentence structure: We will be exploring different narrative styles (1st and 3rd person), exploring verb and adverb structures and ending and how to correctly apply in terms of past, present and future tense. Children will be exploring instructional text, play scripts, fictional and historical contexts. We will be discussing use of language and style.

Writing: Children will be practicing the above explored themes and complimenting them with their writing, to include, writing a fable, imaginative and informational writing.

Grammar and Punctuation: We will be discussing the use of commas and application of pronouns. Children will learn to use and identify pronouns, main clauses, adjectives and prepositions.

Spellings: Spellings from the spelling packs 3A and 3B. Spelling test will be held first thing every Friday morning. Please continue to encourage children to revise for their spellings test and make sentences using the spelling words.

Reading: Guided reading carried out during school hours to monitor on going progress. Focus for this term will be the ebook 'The Dual World of Arnders Arnfield'. Children are highly encouraged to continue reading at home every day.

Numeracy:

- Revise of rounding numbers to the nearest 10,100 and 1000s, roman numerals and negative numbers.
- Securing number facts using money(addition, subtraction, multiplication and division)
- Handling data and measures in volume
- Calculating and understanding shapes and properties of triangles, kites and trapeziums and coordinates
- Working out fraction and converting to decimals.
- Memorising multiplication tables.

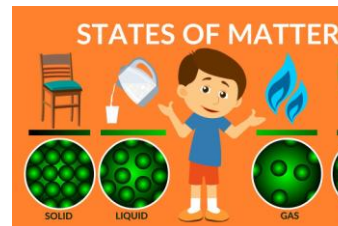
