

YEAR ONE AUTUMN TERM CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

PE- In P.E. this term, the children will focus on movement. They will learn how to move in a variety of ways using different parts of their body. They will also focus on spatial awareness so they understand the importance of moving safely in a space. They will also learn how to balance on different parts of their body.



Mathematics- We will be covering a variety of topics involving number, shape and space, data handling, measures, and problem solving. It would be a great help over the next few weeks if you could practise number bonds to 20, doubles & halves and practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s with your child.



ICT- We will focus on basic keyboard and mouse skills, such as turning on and switching off the computer. The children will also be using Microsoft word to type sentences and save work.



English- In the Autumn Term, we will develop our speaking and listening skills by talking about the use of labels, lists and captions. Children will also create alphabetically ordered lists of different items. Children will also focus on reading poems aloud and will create their own poem about sense.

Science- This half term in science, children will learn about their senses and how they can use them to explore the world around them. They will also learn that humans and other animals move and grow.

Geography- Children will be learning about the local area. They will get the opportunity to walk around the school and identify different locations.



Art & Design- Children will be tasting different fruits and vegetables. They will also develop vocabulary to describe the appearance, taste, smell and texture safely.



PSHE- Children will develop their social skills through circle time activities and games involving skills such as sharing and turn taking. They will learn about taking part and how to work well in a team.
