Numeracy:

Counting, partitioning and calculating

Securing number facts, calculating and identifying relationships.

(We will target to learn all multiplication until the 6 times table by end of December and time terms recognising and applying monetary and time terms correctly.)

Literacy:

Language and sentence structure: We will be exploring different narrative styles from the past (1st and 3rd person), exploring verb and adverb structures and ending and how to correctly apply in terms of past, present and future tense. Discussing the use of commas and application of pronouns.

Exploring instructional text, fictional and historical contexts and discussing use of language and style

Writing: Children will be practicing the above explored themes and complimenting them with their writing.

Spellings: All spellings will be relevant to the topic covered each week, please ensure children learn the weekly spellings.

Reading: Fortnightly library sessions and recording of all reading in reading journal.

Guided reading carried out during school hours to monitor ongoing progress.
